Technical & Area Support Issues

BMLT (Basic Meeting List Toolbox): Several areas reported problems printing accurate meeting lists.

Area support discussions included:

- Collaboration challenges between Hospitals & Institutions (H&I) and Public Relations (PR) committees.
- Questions about MAT/DRT (Medication-Assisted Treatment/Drug Replacement Therapy) panel leaders in facilities.
- Car/Cat workshops and providing virtual access.
- Experiences with learning days and virtual participation.
- Challenges accessing privately-owned jails for H&I service.
- Gender-specific meeting concerns, including how to handle attendance when participants attend meetings not aligned with their gender.
- Discussion of special-interest meetings, such as young persons' Meetings.
- Area election procedures (paper ballots vs. show of placards) and meeting tardiness issues.

Financial & Budget Discussions

The Treasurer reported that the region is spending more than it brings in and clarified current reserves:

- \$9,800 reserved for GSR Assembly
- \$13,600 previously allocated for the discontinued Florida Service Symposium
- \$10,000 FRSC reserve
- \$11,000 prudent reserve

Major discussion centered on how to reallocate the \$13,600 Service Symposium funds, with suggestions including:

- Enhancing or expanding the GSR Assembly (e.g., adding Friday sessions or workshops).
- Keeping the funds reserved until a decision is reached.
- Debate occurred over whether budget approvals should continue under Robert's Rules of Order or shift to Consensus-Based Decision Making (CBDM).
- A proposal was developed to align budget decisions with CBDM while ensuring budgets are still returned to areas for group consideration.
- Consensus was reached to move forward with the proposal as written after testing among RCMs.

Spiritual Impact: Positive spiritual impact in line with current practice of CBDM discussions during budget approval process.

Financial Impact: None, but it will hopefully make for better decisions.

Guide to Florida Regional Service Change: page 20, move # 10 under Financial to Miscellaneous. Also add an instruction requiring the RSC's annual budget be returned to the Areas for consideration, prior to final vote, to the Guide.

Outcome: 10 assent, 5 stand aside, 0 ascend with reservations

Does not meet consensus. It is going back to the Guide for further discussion.
